Game Reserves and Game Destinations – Self Driven / Chauffeur Driven

Tala Private Game Reserve



Tala is situated just outside of Pietermaritzburg and is home to over 300 bird species, Buffalo, Rhino, Kudu, Hippo, Giraffe and the rare Oribi and Sable Antelope. It's excellent for game viewing and wildlife photography as is able to get close to the animals. After the game drive a light lunch will be served in the bushveld. On the way back, you can stop off at Worldsvie for a look over Pietermaritzburg. Here you will be able to see the original track where the Voortrekkers made their way down in the ox wagons. Self-Drive R220 Per person for 2 hour game drive. Guided Tour R1100 per person including lunch and 2 hour game drive.

Nambiti Game Reserve – Game Drive



Nambiti is the only reserve in the area with the Big 5 (Elephant, Rhino, Lion, Leopard & Buffalo), and currently has over forty other species of game including cheetah, giraffe, hippo, hyena, impala, springbok & zebra. It is only 1.5 hours from Granny Mouse

The Reserve's 22,000 acres boasts incredible biodiversity including savannah, thornveld, ravine bush, majestic acacia trees and extensive grasslands that mirror the plains of central Africa. The reserve is completely malaria free, and is one of the

few private reserves in Africa where species have the space and habitat to display their natural tendencies. The size of the reserve allows herbivores to roam in large herds, as they would have done in centuries past.

Self-Drive R250 per person including 4 hour game drive. R500 per person including a 4 hour game drive and a 3 course lunch or dinner.

Nambiti Game Reserve – Cheetah Experience



Nambiti also offers a Cheetah Experience. Guests get to watch a demonstration of the cheetahs speed as it chases a dummy, they then get the opportunity to enter the enclosure and interact with the animals. This happens twice a day at 11am and 2pm for R300 per person. The total interaction is between 1 and 2 hours. The Guided Tour option is R1500 per person which includes 3 hour game drive, lunch & the cheetah experience

Nambiti is only an hour and a half drive from us. They pick up the guests from Memorial Gate in a 4x4.

Birds of Prey Sanctuary & Ishona Langa Wildlife Sanctuary

Situated in the beautiful Mpushini River Valley, this raptor center is home to over 50 different species of bird. The centre is for research, breeding and rehabilitation; and a great many of their birds are successfully released back into the wild. Watch a display of these amazing predators in flight and afterwards go to lunch at Ishona Langa Wildlife Sanctuary. Ishona Langa, “The place where the sun sets” is also a registered Primate Sanctuary and is home to several Samango and Vervet Monkeys.

The canopy of the indigenous acacias creates a tranquil bushveld mood in which to relax and enjoy yourself. Ishona Longa was established as a place where wild animals that have been traumatized could find a refuge whilst they are rehabilitated. It is a nonprofit undertaking that is sustained by the facilities that it offers. Self-Drive R50 per person, Guided Tour R550 per person
